

## **Foothills Christian Church Reopening FAQ's November 19, 2020**

### **For Staff and Volunteers:**

Staff and Volunteers will not serve if they are sick.

Facial Coverings mandatory if within 6 feet of others.

Volunteers and staff will maintain a 6 feet distance between one another and any visitor.

Bathroom attendants will be placed at each bathroom door and allow only 50% of the capacity of persons allowed at a time.

Counter tops, Doorknobs, handles and common areas will be disinfected frequently.

Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the facility.

### **Cleaning and Safety Procedures, Foothills Christian Church**

To protect our Church family and meet CDC guidelines, the following is a brief description our procedures.

We are using the VP300ES Victory Electrostatic Backpack Sprayer with the Performex Disinfectant cleaner from Brulin.

After every scheduled event here at Foothills, we spray the room, the lobbies and all bathrooms with the VP300ES Victory Electrostatic Backpack Sprayer.

On a continuing rotation, wipe down all door handles, panic bars, desks and counter tops, keypads, sinks and any other surfaces that are touched by hand.

A disinfectant is applied during mopping of all non-carpeted surfaces.

HVAC systems (Heating and Air Conditioning) are running on a consistent basis in order to move 40,000 cubic feet per minute of air and prevent the Covid-19 virus from lingering in the main sanctuary alone.

### **Room set-ups for Social Distancing**

All events require and are set-up to ensure a six-foot distance between all Church attendees.

Sanctuary Seating, our Usher Team are responsible and for the seating and releasing of all Church attendees in order to ensure the six feet distancing guidelines.

### **For Church Attendees:**

All Attendees who are at risk, sick, or immunocompromised will be encouraged to stay home and attend services online.

The Patio doors will be the only entrance to the Sanctuary and Overflow. They will be clearly marked. Each Attendee will have a no-touch Thermoscan before entering the buildings.

All Attendees must wear facemasks until they are seated in the auditorium.

There will be 3 services provided: Saturday 6:30pm, Sunday 9:00am, and 10:45am to reduce the number of attendees to maximum of 25% sanctuary capacity.

Every other row will not be available for seating. Attendees in the same household will be allowed to sit together and will maintain a social distance from others.

Signs will be posted throughout the facility to remind Attendees of the six feet apart protocol and to wear facemasks.

Attendees have various giving options: Electronically on the Foothills App, and Website, in person there will be no offering plates. There will be an Offering Dropbox at each sanctuary exit.

After service all attendees will be directed to exit without congregating in the lobby or patio areas.
